“1 Preliminary Practice of Great Compassion

As stated in the Avatamsaka Sutra, Volume 40:

Ven. Yinyue (Chengli LI) is duly elected as the Chairperson of the Committee.

Ven. Yinyue thanked members for their support but noted that her work on compiling the 'Great Compassion' book series must come first.

Consequently, she has entrusted the current Chairperson, Yuping HE, to stay in office until she is ready to take over.
